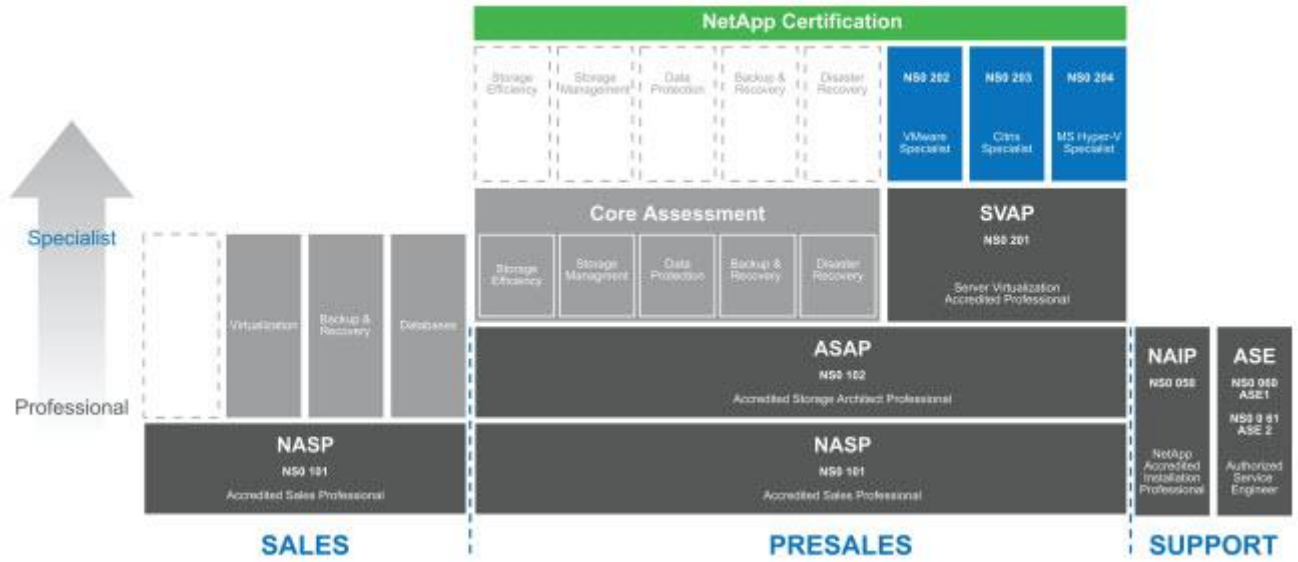

All accreditation exams are now located in the [NetApp University LearningCenter](#), making them easier to access and manage.

- In the LearningCenter, the accreditation exams have the same user interface as the accreditation courses
- Single sign on lets you access the exams using your NetApp login
- Each exam that you successfully complete is recorded in your learning transcript
- You can print your own certificates locally
- All sales personnel, SEs, PSs, and channel partners access the exams from one location

NetApp University Accreditation FAQ

Why are the accreditation exams migrating from the Prometric testing site to the NetApp LearningCenter?

The accreditation exams are moving to make them easier for partners and employees to access. Now you can go to the NetApp LearningCenter to register for and complete your accreditation exams instead of having to log in to the Prometric site. In the LearningCenter, the exams will have the same interface that you use to register for training. Your training and exam results will automatically be consolidated into your NetApp® LearningCenter transcript.

How much does it cost to take a NetApp accreditation exam?

NetApp accreditation exams are free.

How should I prepare for my accreditation exam?

One of the best ways to prepare for an exam is to take the NetApp University training courses that map to the exam. For example, if you are taking the NetApp Accredited Storage Architect Professional exam, we recommend that you first complete the NetApp Accredited Storage Architect Program training. For a list of recommended courses for your exam, download the Detailed Description PDF from the exam page in the LearningCenter.

Can I retake an accreditation exam?

You can attempt each NetApp accreditation exam three times before your access is blocked. We recommend that you wait 10 calendar days between attempts.

When will I receive my accreditation certificate?

Your accreditation certificate will be available immediately after you successfully complete an exam. You can print your certificate directly from the LearningCenter or you can choose to print it to an Adobe PDF file.

If you log out without printing your certificate, you can return to the LearningCenter to print your certificate at any time. To do this, log in to the LearningCenter and launch the exam to open the exam results page and your certificate. This is possible only if you have exam attempts available. If you do not, please contact NetApp University Support for assistance.

Will my accreditation expire?

NetApp University accreditations are valid for two years from the date of your successful exam completion. To renew your accreditation, you must complete the reaccreditation requirements. If you let your accreditation expire, you must repeat the entire exam process to regain your accreditation status.

What about my existing accreditations?

Accreditations that have not expired are valid and can be added to your transcript. If you are a NetApp employee, contact your manager to add your accreditation exam results to your LearningCenter transcript. If you are a NetApp partner, contact [NetApp University Support](#).



Why are the certification exams not being moved?

The certification exams are not being moved to the LearningCenter because they are conducted in person by Prometric, a third-party testing organization. To learn more about how to locate a test center and schedule a test, visit the [Prometric Web site](#).
